Areas of study <i>not</i> available to exchange students	None, but at least half (50 % or more) of the course modules have to be within the Faculty of Science.  Students are allowed to take cross-faculty modules but this is subject to approval by the course offering faculty/department.	
Level of courses	Exchange students are normally allowed to take courses on both bachelor (undergraduate) level and master (graduate) if requirements are met.	
Full time course load per semester	30 credits ("hp") per semester is considered full time. 60 hp per year.  Maximum course load per semester is 30 credits plus one 7,5 credits Swedish (SVEE) course.	
Language requirements	It is important that the student has sufficient proficiency in English language to be able to study the courses open to exchange students. It is <i>recommended</i> that the student has a proficiency corresponding to IELTS 6.5 / TOEFL 90 / B2.
